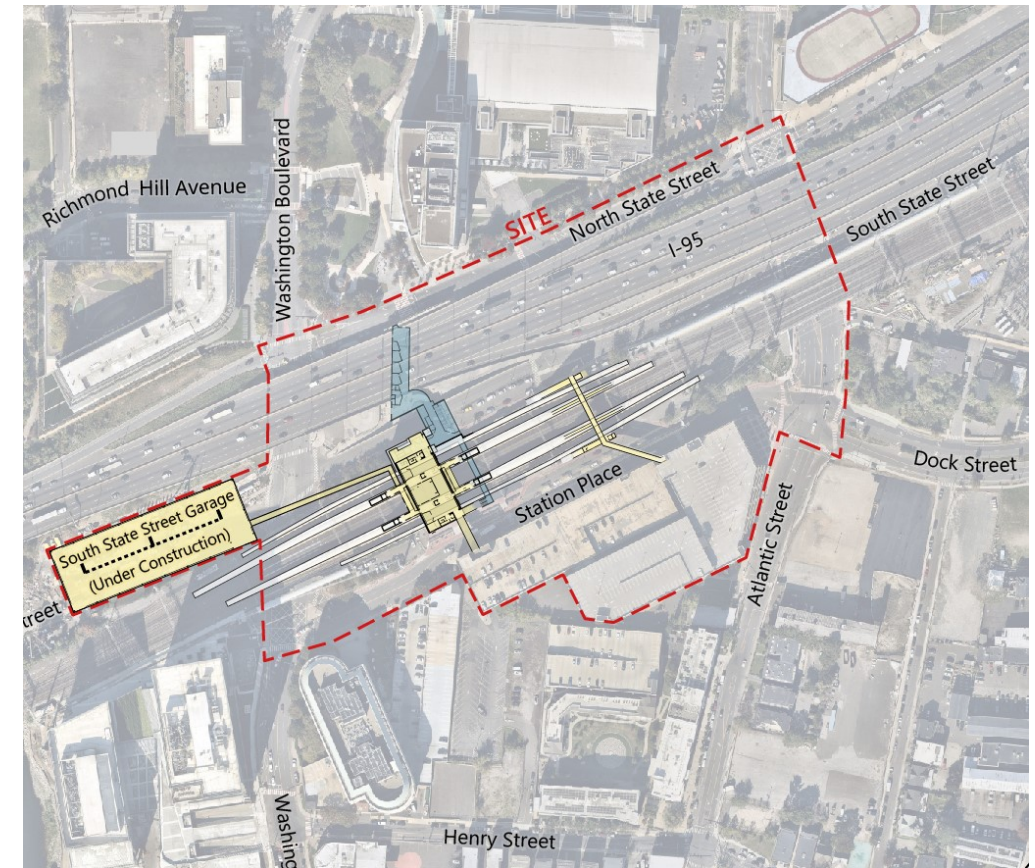


# Stamford Transportation Center (STC) Master Plan



## STC Master Plan Purpose and Goal

- 28,300 customers (pre-COVID) each day as well as private shuttle operators, buses, taxis, and transportation network companies (Uber and Lyft).
- Purpose: review and evaluate the existing STC complex and provide recommendations and conceptual improvements.
- Goal: develop a Master Plan that provides a new vision of the STC that transforms the complex into a best-in-class facility.



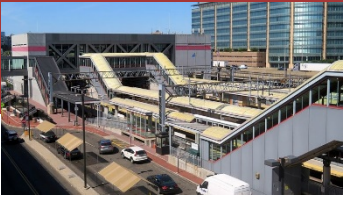

Denver Union Station



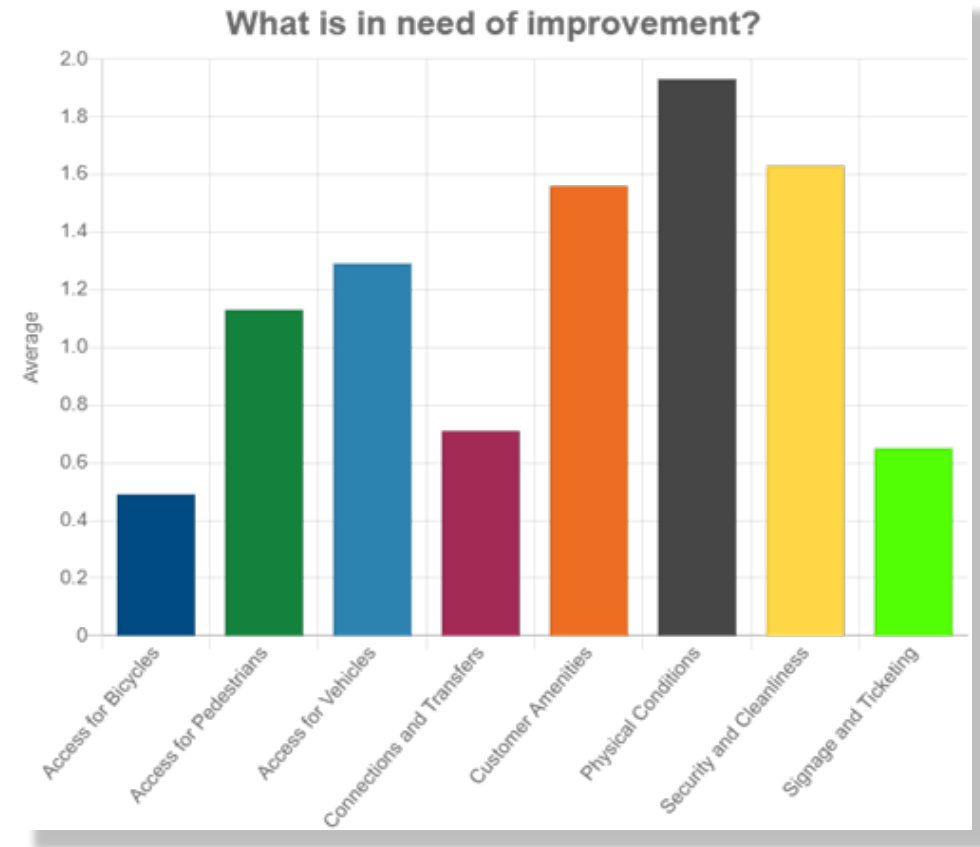
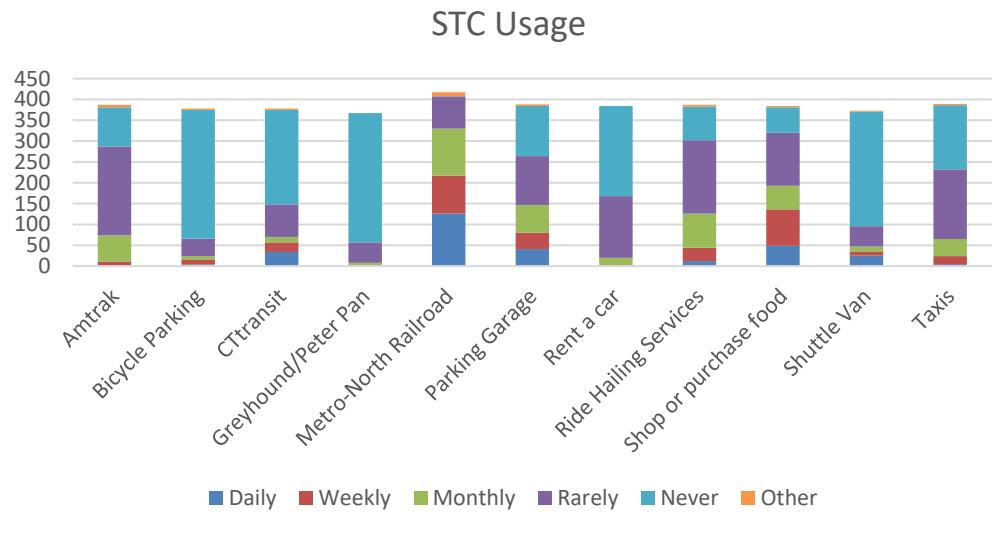
